### *Bridging the Past and Future of Fine Watchmaking.*

Neuchâtel, 25 March 2008: The concept Time æon was born nearly three years ago following a series of reports and the recognition of some serious shortcomings in the watch industry.

The key issues reported were:

- A significant loss of expertise and knowledge of how to be a watchmaker.
- The devaluation of watchmaking as an occupation.
- The decreasing number of specialist training courses.
- The worrying disappearance of a highly qualified labour force.
- The non-recognition of the art of contemporary watchmaking as practised by independent artists.
- The extreme difficulty encountered by young independent artists starting out.

After lengthy reflection and following experimentation with a number of different organizational models, it became evident to everyone that the solution was to create a foundation – the only way to really address the objectives we have set for ourselves. A foundation will also have a bigger impact on the watchmaking industry.

Thus the Time æon Foundation was created on 4 March 2008, registered in Neuchâtel, canton Neuchâtel. The foundation supersedes all previous incarnations, namely Time æon Alliance, Heritage and Enterprise.
